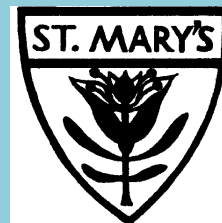

Dear Parents,

I just wanted to clarify a couple of really good questions that some parents had asked about reports.

Report scores

In their Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 SATs the children are given an age standardised score with 100 as the average. Between Year 2 and Year 6 there are no National tests so in order to continue to track progress and provide support to those children that need it we use PiRA, PuMA and SWST. PiRA is a Reading assessment tool and provides a standardised score to measure progress in reading comprehension. PuMA does the same for Maths whilst SWST helps the school track spelling and vocabulary. There are several different tests and providers but they all aim to produce a Standardised score in which 100 is the average.

Reports for Year 3

Due to the departure of Miss Burrows Year 3 reports were issued before the Easter break. All Year 3 parents should have received an annual attendance report on Friday as this was not available at Easter.
